A Message from the Pastor

This weekend's gospel could be called "The Story of Dogged Persistence." The Canaanite woman will simply not be ignored or discouraged by Jesus' attempts to ignore her or deny her request. She demonstrates a "plucky" spirit. In other words, she demonstrates courage in the face of difficulties, obstacles and even danger. When the health and well-being of her daughter are at stake, she will not settle for anything less.

There is a parental phenomenon in universities that troubles many who work in tertiary education. It is the phenomenon of "helicopter" parents or overly protective and solicitous parents. In fact, some "helicopter" parents have graduated to become "kamikaze" parents. This happens when parents don't just "hover" over their sons and daughters during their college careers but literally "fight" their battles for them with the system as well as with particular Deans and Professors. While well-intentioned, this misguided care does nothing to develop appropriate assertiveness and self-preservation skills in their college-age children.

The Canaanite woman's intervention, on behalf of her ailing daughter, is quite appropriate. She demonstrates both a great heart and an indefatigable spirit. It is the type of heart sung about by the character Van Buren in the musical *Damn Yankees*.

should start.

You gotta have hope, mustn't sit around and mope. Nothin's half as bad as it may appear, wait'll next year and hope.

Pastor's Message continued from page one:



Aikido honors the energy of the other but gently redirects it. Humor is a form of aikido. In this gospel passage, the Canaanite woman utilizes her wit, her pluck and her humor to attain her desired

outcome. May she be an example and inspiration for us the next time we run into discouragement, disappointment or even initial failure as we work to achieve some important goal in life. Like the Canaanite



woman, we need to take the long view rather than the short one. We need to keep our "eye on the prize" and utilize those God-given gifts of humor, wit and hope to get the blessing and healing of Christ that week seek for those we love and serve.




