### A Message from the Pastor

The third of Dora Bittau's panels is entitled "Educated and Blessed with Companions at the University of Paris." St. Ignatius is front and center in

this icon that depicts him in the halls of the University of Paris. He holds a book open that has the Latin phrase which has become one of the best known mottos of St. Ignatius and the Jesuits—Ad Majorem Dei Gloriam—which means "For the greater glory of God."

In this icon, Ignatius is surrounded by students from the 16<sup>th</sup> century as well as the 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> century. Ignatius realized that to continue teaching the faith and offering spiritual advice he needed credentials. That meant he had to study philosophy and theology at the University of Paris. God was continuing to educate Ignatius slowly—step by step. St. Ignatius would even describe his slow growth in the knowledge of things spiritual as God teaching him like a young schoolboy. Ignatius pursued an education so he could help others and serve God.


Some people make life-long friends in college. It was no different for St. Ignatius. He met his first companions, who would become the Society of Jesus, at the



University of Paris. His college roommates were St. Peter Faber and St. Francis Xavier. Ignatius gradually gave *The Spiritual Exercises* to both Faber and Xavier. Whether they would eventually travel to Jerusalem and serve the poor or travel to Rome and make themselves available for whatever and wherever the Pope wished to send them to do some small good for the Church, St. Ignatius knew that education would provide a solid foundation for their ministry.

St. Ignatius also knew that education was a way to change many of the abuses that existed in the Church of his day. While the Reformation leaders tried to do this from outside the Church, St. Ignatius' efforts were from within. From the very beginning, the Society of Jesus was given the mission of educating young people. As Jesuit Pedro de Ribadeneira once said, "All the well-being of Christianity and of the whole world depends on the proper education of youth."

In the United States alone there are 28 Jesuit Colleges and Universities as well as over 59 High Schools. But Jesuit values permeate even our Grade School as the five Jesuits on our staff visit classes weekly and work with our teachers and aids in so many different ways in the education of the School children.

It is through education—in the classroom, in the pulpit, in Bulletin Messages from your Pastor, in the celebration of the sacraments, in fund-raising and friend-raising events, in formal and informal conversations—that we discover and strengthen those Ignatian values of finding

God in all things, discernment (how to make good decisions), the service of faith and promotion of

justice, care for the whole person, striving for excellence (*magis*), and becoming men and women for others.

As poet William Butler Yeats remarked, "Education is not the filling of a pail, but the lighting of a fire." As God slowly taught St. Ignatius of Loyola, he lit a fire in him that would never be extinguished. And Ignatius' great desire for his first companions and for us is captured in his challenge, "Go set the world on fire."

If you are thinking of donating food, the pantry could use soups, peanut butter, as well as canned vegetables and fruit.


