## A Message from the Pastor

The Feast of the Transfiguration is celebrated on the 6<sup>th</sup> of August. Because that day falls on a weekend this year, that Feast replaces the celebra-

tion of the 18<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time. This particular event—the Transfiguration—is always the gospel for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Lent. In getting a glimpse of Christ's glory, we get a "preview of coming attractions"—the glory God wills for each and every follower of his Son. This weekend let us remember what St. Irenaeus proclaimed 1,800 years ago—"The glory of God is the human being fully alive."


There are two lines, in this weekend's gospel, that stand out for me. The voice from the cloud says to the disciples and to us, "Listen to him." When you come to church and hear the scriptures—"Listen to him." When you juggle all the commitments you have in life and wear all those different hats—"Listen to him." When you care for a sickly child or a parent whose health and/or memory is failing—"Listen to him." When you are confronted with conflicting values and seemingly contradictory choices—"Listen to him."



The other line in the gospel that touches me right now comes after the three disciples have experienced something they simply don't understand. Jesus touches them and says, "Rise, and do not be afraid." When you have more to do that you think you have time or ability for—"Rise, and do not be afraid." When you experience frustration or failure after incredible effort—"Rise, and do not be afraid." "When you are disgusted with what our elected representatives are doing or failing to do—"Rise, and do not be afraid." When you are not even sure if you still have an ounce of faith or hope or love left in you—"Rise, and do not be afraid."

Three things help me understand a little better what the mystery (something that cannot be fully understood or explained) of the Transfiguration is all about. Those three things are a movie I saw, the news of a dear friend's death, and the lyrics of a song.

### Pastor's Message continued from page one:

The movie is called "Dunkirk." It is named for a beach in France where 400,000 British soldiers were stranded as the advancing Germans pressed them into the sea. It happened at the beginning of World War II before the United States entered the conflict. When there seemed no way of saving these British lives, Winston Churchill (Prime Minister) got on the radio and called for the people to rescue these men. And the people responded. They used whatever boats they had—fishing boats, skiffs, yachts, even a canoe and a paddle steamer—and made the trip over the eight days of the miracle of Dunkirk. Through all of the suffering and dying, glory shone through. Those boats recued 360,000 of the 400,000 stranded troops. The indomitable spirit of the British people shone through.

The friend who died was Sr. Anne-Marie Mongoven. She was a Sinsinawa Dominican and co-founder of the Graduate Pastoral Ministries Program at Santa Clara University, along with her dear friend and collaborator Sr. Rita Claire Dorner. She was a wonderful mentor and colleague to me during my years at Santa Clara University (1985-1996). She had incredible knowledge, wisdom and passion for passing on the faith (catechetics). She had that rare ability to combine theory and practice in her life and teaching. She left this world a better place for being here. She left me a better person for working with her

and knowing her. When I received word of her death, I immediately thought of Maya

Angelou's poem, "When Great Trees Fall."

The lyrics are from a song that occurs at the end of the film *Selma*. They are written by John Legend and capture the essence of the glory that emerges through struggle. *Selma* documents the struggle of African Americans for the right to vote that is guaranteed by our Constitution but was denied—and continues to be denied—in certain parts of our country.



One day, when the glory comes
It will be ours, it will be ours.
Oh, one day, when the war is won
We will be sure, we will be here sure.
When the war is done, when it's all said and done,
We'll cry glory, oh glory.

May this feast and the words of the gospel help us to genuinely "listen to him" and discover more and more ways to be fully alive. It is in this way that God's glory shines through us—always has and always will.




