

## A Message from the Pastor

This weekend, we celebrate one of the great Christian mysteries—the Most Holy Trinity. The Trinity is one of the great mysteries of our faith. We don't think about it that often, and yet we immerse ourselves in that mystery every time we make the sign of the cross—"In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen." It is how we began this liturgy and how we will conclude it with our blessing and sending forth.

For many western Christians, the Trinity is scarcely an object of devotion even if the person of Jesus Christ—the Second Person of the Trinity—is. Yet for our Irish Christian ancestors it was the presence of the Trinity that was powerfully felt. We hear this in many of the ancient prayers preserved in the *Carmina Gadelica*.

The Three Who are over me,  
The Three Who are below me,  
The Three Who are above me here,  
The Three Who are above me yonder;  
The Three Who are in the earth,  
The Three Who are in the air,  
The Three Who are in the heaven,  
The Three Who are in the great pouring sea.

According to Philip Sheldrake, this sense of closeness to a God who is one-in-three, a community of persons in a harmonious and equal unity, probably reflects the strong sense of family, household, and kin that early Irish society enjoyed.



When we think about the Persons of the Trinity, both individually and collectively, they can offer us wisdom for our Christian journey. Individually, we can think about what each person of the Trinity does and how that is reflected in each of our lives.

## PASTOR'S MESSAGE CONTINUED FROM PAGE ONE:

We can think of the making and creating role of the Father, and how much in our life can be seen as co-operation with that—anything we do to create, to awaken, to cherish new life; what we do to mold and shape the environment, such as the clearing of undergrowth that strangles the new life in a neglected corner of the garden, our manual work that beautifies our home and community, as well as the more profound creating of new human flesh and the cherishing of that new life in your children's early years. The poet creates with words. The homemaker creates tasty meals. This creativity, this imitation of the Creator—the First Person of the Trinity—is only limited by our ability or inability to imagine.

The Second Person of the Trinity—the Redeemer—bought our freedom through the outpouring of his life. To him we can commend all our efforts in working with people, teaching and listening, coaching and encouraging, trying to expand inner horizons, trying to widen hearts and imaginations through sharing with others what we ourselves have received from our study of St. Benedict, St. Catherine of Siena, St. Teresa of Avila, Thomas Merton, Dorothy Day, Mother Theresa or the Celtic tradition.


The Third Person of the Trinity—the Sanctifier, the Nurturer—is the Spirit, the Advocate that Jesus promised to send us. To this person of the Trinity we can commend all the work of compassion and healing and forgiveness that must happen time and again throughout our lives, the mending and making whole again, and how our own receiving of the gifts of compassion and acceptance and forgiveness can be shared.

But we can also imagine and reflect on the Trinity working together as one. As Australian Jesuit Richard Leonard reminds us, "Trinity Sunday celebrates that whether we are in crisis or not, in season or out of season, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit do nothing but "pull together" to love and save us. What we may glimpse as the best attribute of our family, our town, our faith community or nation defines who our Christian God is, and what they see, how they judge, and the way they act toward the world.'

"In practical terms it is impossible to profess belief in the Trinity, on the one hand, and then work at things that pull the human family apart, on the other. It is scandalous to hold to the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit and be known as a racist, a bigot, age-ist or sexist, to not care about migrants or refugees or those who die each day of starvation. We cannot keep signing ourselves in the name of the Triune God and then work hard at getting richer and more secure while the rest of humanity grows poorer and lacks the necessities of human dignity. Gandhi once said, 'I love the New Testament and the Christian ideas about God, and I would take the waters of Christian baptism tomorrow if I saw Christians practice what they preach.'"

Let us pray that on this feast of the Trinity, through the scriptures we hear and the Eucharist we share, that we can believe in what we say and become what we believe, "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."


