## A Message from the Pastor

This weekend we celebrate the birth of the Church. This weekend we celebrate that Jesus was true to his word. He did not leave us orphans but sent us the gift of the Holy Spirit. This weekend we could talk about the gifts of the Spirit (e.g. wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord) or the fruits of the Spirit (e.g. charity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, long-suffering, humility, fidelity, modesty, continence, and chastity). Instead, I would like to focus on three words linked to the working of the Holy Spirit that Pope Francis pointed out. Those three words are newness, harmony, and mission.

Newness always makes us a bit fearful. We feel more secure if we have everything under control, if we are the ones who build, program, and plan our lives in accordance with our own ideas, our own comfort, our own preferences. This is also the case with God. But throughout salvation history, whenever God reveals himself, he brings newness and change, and demands our complete trust—it was true of Noah; it was true of Abraham; it was true of Moses; it was true of the first apostles; and it is true of us.

The newness which God brings into our life is something that actually brings fulfillment, that gives true joy, true serenity, because God loves us and desires only our good. So, on Pentecost, we can ask ourselves: Are we open to God's surprises? Or are we closed and fearful before the newness of the Holy Spirit?

The second word is harmony. The Holy Spirit would appear to create disorder in the Church since he brings the diversity of charisms and gifts. But this variety paradoxically leads everything back to harmony. There are a variety of gifts but always the same Spirit. There are different kinds of service to be done but always to the same Lord. Only the Spirit can awaken diversity, plurality, and multiplicity,

while at the same time building unity. So, on Pentecost, we ask ourselves: Are we open to the harmony of the Holy Spirit? Do we let the Spirit guide us in the Church, in our St. Ignatius faith community, in our city of Portland, and in our world?

## PASTOR'S MESSAGE CONTINUED FROM PAGE ONE:

The last word is mission. Early theologians used to say that the soul is a kind of sailboat, and the Holy Spirit is the wind which fills its sails and drives it forward, and the gusts of wind are the gifts of the Spirit. The events which happened in Jerusalem almost 2,000 years ago are not something far removed from us. Pentecost is happening now. The Holy Spirit is the supreme gift of the risen Christ to his first apostles and also to us. So, on Pentecost, we can ask: Do we tend to stay closed in on ourselves, on our group, or do we let the Holy Spirit open us to mission?

We see evidence of the Holy Spirit at work in all those who pray and work for those in need. We see the Holy Spirit at work in those who generously give of their time and talent in our liturgies, in our religious education classes, in the work of Tibbetts House, in the those involved in Just Faith, in the outreach of our St. Vincent de Paul Society. We see the Holy Spirit at work in those who comfort all who mourn, in those who care for the ill, the elderly and the homebound. We see the Holy Spirit at work in all those who share their treasure weekly in this parish. It is the Holy Spirit who teaches us to be grateful, and generous, and full of hope.

Pastor Steve Garnaas-Holmes, in his poem *Hearing Them*, has the Spirit whisper, in each of the above-mentioned experiences, "We need you." Listen to that voice. Listen to that Spirit. He concludes with these words:

*In my window seat I pray  
for that inner Pentecost  
when what is impossible  
falls upon me, flows through me,  
through all of us,  
like fire.*



And so, on this Pentecost weekend, we pray: "Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, and kindle in them the fire of your love!"


