

## A Message from the Pastor

If this weekend's Gospel were to take place here and now, what would be some of our responses to Jesus' call to "follow me." Consciously or unconsciously, we let so many agendas, interests and activities monopolize the focus of our lives. Jesus' call to discipleship, however, demands a total, focused commitment to the Gospel that affects every moment, every decision, every relationship of our lives. To "follow" Jesus is to see that the true joy and meaning of God's gift of this life of ours is found in the hard but often hidden work of making the reign of God a reality in our time and in our place.



When Bob Geldof met Mother Teresa, he was both impressed and daunted by her work. "I could never do what you do," he said. She held his hand and said, "Remember this. I can do something you can't do and you can do something I can't do. But we both have to do it."

God calls each of us through the sacraments. In baptism, God welcomes us and invites us into the faith family where we will discover his presence in the people who gather, in the scriptures that are proclaimed, in the meal that is shared, and in all the ways we carry God's presence and love into the world. In the sacrament of Reconciliation, God forgives us and calls us to be catalysts of forgiveness and reconciliation in our families, in our communities and our world. In the Eucharist God feeds us and calls us to share our bread with the hungry and our drink with the thirsty all around us. In Confirmation, God pours out his spirit to strengthen us in responding to his call and the challenges of his Gospel. In the sacrament of Anointing, God heals us and reminds us again how his power works best in our weakness. God calls us, through the sacrament of anointing, to be signs of God's healing and God's hope to all those who are suffering around us. In the sacrament of Matrimony, God gives us the capacity to make promises and commitments out of love. God calls us to struggle daily to live those promises and renew those commitments. In the sacrament of Orders, God calls people from our midst to minister to God's people, to be signs to the faithful of God's compassionate and faithful presence in every blessing they experience and every life-giving challenge that they face.

## PASTOR'S MESSAGE CONTINUED FROM PAGE ONE:

In his book *The Way of Man*, Martin Buber narrates two stories, from the Hasidic Jewish tradition, that shed light on our call and how we respond to that call. Rabbi Baer of Cracow once said to his teacher, the 'Seer' of Lublin, 'Show me one general way to the service of God.'

The zaddik replied, 'It is impossible to tell people what way they should take. For one way to serve God is through learning, another through prayer, another through fasting, and still another through eating. Everyone should carefully observe what way his heart draws him to, and then choose this way with all his strength.'

The maggid of Zolchov was asked by a Hasid, 'We are told—"Everyone in Israel is in duty bound to say: When will my work approach the works of our fathers Abraham, Isaac and Jacob?" How are we to understand this? How could we ever think that we could do what our fathers in faith have done?' The rabbi explained: 'Just as our fathers in faith founded new ways of serving, each a new service according to his character—one the service of love, the other that of stern justice, the third that of beauty, so each one of us in his or her own way shall devise something new in the light of teachings and of service, and do what has not yet been done.'



God calls us each week, each day, to follow him in the small and large challenges and commitments of our life. May the scriptures we hear, may the Eucharist we share, may the community of faith of which we are a part—strengthen us to say "Yes" from a heart full of gratitude and generosity.


